Tuition Discounts: **Multi-Child Discount:** \$300 for each student subsequent to the first student enrolled. The discount will change relative to any financial aid accepted by the family. For example: 25% financial aid will lower the \$300 discount to \$225.00

Volunteer Discount: A \$300 discount for any FAMILY providing 15 hours of approved school service. For more information please contact school administration.

*This option requires utilizing automatic bank draft. Payments are withdrawn the first or fifteenth of each month (July-April).
